Ordering Quantity:

> LINERS 105, 102, and 84 ARE DISCONTINUED FOR PREBOOK - These liners are currently being phased out, but may appear on Weekly Excess. They will no longer be available once sold out.

> Our plants are grown in Split 102 Liners. Each liner contains 51 plugs and are 1" hex in size.

> Minimum quantity to order is 50 plugs per plant variety.

> Liner prices are based on the nearest tenth integer, meaning the additional 1 plug in a Split 102 is not charged.

Prebooking:

> Prebook orders are orders placed in advance of your growing season.

> Your order is put into production 12 full weeks ahead of your selected ship date to ensure optimal size for shipping and transplanting. The 12 week lead time is required. Therefore, orders submitted with ship dates sooner than the required lead time cannot be confirmed.

> Late February to early April is our most popular shipping time of the year and we usually sell out before October 31st. Aside from the EOD opportunity, ordering early ensures your highest chance of receiving your plants within your time frame. If an order is placed for a week that is sold out, we will move it to our next available date and note the change on your acknowledgement.

Quality Issues & Claims:

> Our claims protocol requests you transplant what you can, and follow up with a total loss of plugs.

> The final claim, with your total loss of plugs, must be made no later than two weeks after the shipments delivery date. The total loss of plugs determines the correct amount of credit/replacements you will receive.

> Once the claim has been approved, a credit memo will be issued or you may request replacements.

Balm Lemon <i>Melissa officinalis</i>	p, fs, bf, dr	12" - 18"	Fresh lemon flavor for culinary and medicinal purposes.
Basil African Blue <i>Ocimum kilimandscharicum</i> x <i>basilicum</i>	a, fs, bf	36" - 48"	Edible green-purple foliage and flower spikes. Culinary and medicinal purposes.
Basil Amethyst <i>Ocimum basilicum</i>	a, fs, bf	16" - 20"	Beautiful purple foliage that are almost black. The darkest purple basil with a classic basil flavor.
Basil Genovese <i>Ocimum basilicum</i>	a, fs, bf	24" - 36"	Sweet flavored basil that is the most favorable for making pesto.

Stevia <i>Stevia rebaudiana</i>	tp, fs	12" - 36"	Super sweet, green foliage and white flowers. Used as a sugar substitute.
Tarragon French <i>Artemisia dracunculus</i>	p, fs, dr	24" - 36"	Narrow, green leaves have a spicy licorice aroma and flavor. Used to elevate dishes, along with other culinary
Thyme Archers Gold <i>Thymus x citriodorus</i>	p, fs, bf, dr	6" - 9"	Bright yellow foliage with a lemon scent. Pale purple flowers. Good for walkways.
Thyme Doone Valley <i>Thymus x citriodorus</i>	p, fs, bf, dr	4" - 5"	Dark green leaves with splashes of yellow in cool weather. Mauve-pink flowers, ornamental.
Thyme English <i>Thymus vulgaris</i>	p, fs, bf, dr	6" - 12"	Small, round foliage that is low maintenance and commonly used for culinary purposes.
