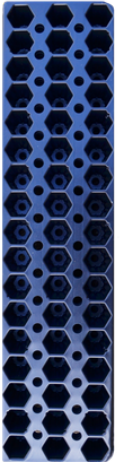

### Ordering Quantity:

> Our plants are grown in 51 of split 102 liners. Each liner contains 51 plugs and are 1" hex in size.

> Minimum quantity to order is 50 plugs per plant variety.

> Liner prices are based on the nearest tenth integer, meaning the additional 1 plug is not charged.



### Prebooking & Early Order Discount (EOD):

> **Placing your prebook in advance may grant you a discount on your order.**

> EOD orders must be placed by October 15, 2026, for shipment January 4 to June 28, 2027.

> Minimum order required to receive EOD is 1,200 plugs (24 liners) per ship date.

### EOD Guide:

\$1.00 off per 100 plugs on orders of 1200 plugs.

\$1.50 off per 100 plugs on orders of 1300 to 4000 plugs.

\$2.00 off per 100 plugs on orders of 4100 plugs or more.

\*Early Order Discount is applied to the final invoice\*



## Prebooking:

> Prebook orders are orders placed in advance of your growing season.

> Your order is put into production at least 12 weeks ahead of your selected ship date to ensure optimal size for shipping and transplanting. **The 12 week lead time is required.**

> **Ship dates for late February to early April will likely sell out before October 31st.** If an order is placed for a week that is sold out, we will move it to our next available date and note the change on your acknowledgement.

> In the event it is too late to prebook your order, excess availability is available to order from the week before your selected ship date.

**\*\*Production changes and cancellations are handled on a case-by-case basis\*\***

## Weekly Excess Availability:

> Our excess availability are any extra plants left over from prebook sales.

- Excess availability does not have a specific day that it goes live, but we strive to host it every week.

> You may opt-in for email alerts for our cell pack availability by emailing: [orders@hillcrestnursery.com](mailto:orders@hillcrestnursery.com).

> We do not sell these trays in advance. They are available to ship the following week only.

**\*\*Late February - early April (weeks 9-15), we may not have an excess availability due to our shipping capacity being reached.\*\***

## Placing an Order:

> Prebook and excess orders can be placed online under their respective tabs.

> You will need shipping and billing info, and payment information upon placing your order.

- Please note: Credit/debit payments are not processed until the week before the order ship date.

> For full boxing we can ship 8, 6, or 4 liners in our boxes. We do not have an order minimum.

- 8-6 liners fit in a large box

- 4 or less ships in a small box.

## Plant Tags:

- > Plant tags are available for \$8.50 per bundle of 50.
- > **A restocking fee of 5% will be charged if tags are cancelled from an order.**
- > Tags are required for patented herbs with a royalty charge.
- > Tags may not be available for all items.



## Shipping & Freight:

- > We ship via UPS and FedEx. Air cargo collect is available under select circumstances.
  - > Freight is determined based on location and selected service. UPS is usually the cheapest.
  - > Customer pick-up is available Tuesday-Friday, 7-2, with notice to our office.
  - > Boxes can hold:
    - Large Box: 8-6 liners
    - Small Box: 4 or less liners
- \*\*During extreme temperatures, we reserve the right to delay shipping until safe for plant material\*\***



## Additional Charges:

- > Boxing charge: \$9.30/box.
- > Drayage charge to airport: \$6.00/box.
- > Winter boxing: \$5.00/box.
  - Winter boxing is required in the case of extreme cold or weather conditions that would result in unhealthy plants upon delivery.

> Initial claim via email is necessary within 24 hours of delivery.

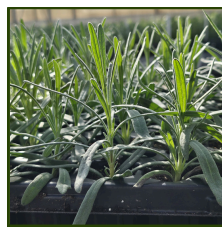

<b>Balm Lemon</b> Melissa officinalis	p, fs, bf, dr	12"-18"	Fresh, lemon flavor for soups, salads, sauces and teas
<b>Basil African Blue</b> Ocimum x kilimandscharicum x basilicum	a, fs, bf	36"-48"	Purplish-green leaves, purple flower spikes
<b>Basil Amethyst</b> Ocimum basilicum	a, fs, bf	16"-20"	Nice, thick, turned down leaves are almost black. The darkest purple basil
<b>Basil Genovese</b> Ocimum basilicum	a, fs, bf	24"-36"	The best for pesto! Dark green foliage
<b>Basil Greek Columnar</b> Ocimum x citriodorum	a, fs, bf	24"-36"	Green leaves, narrow, upright habit. Sweet flavor, rarely flowers
<b>Basil Holy Kapoor Tulsi</b> Ocimum africanum	a, fs, bf	12"-18"	Many cultures find this plant sacred, with many medicinal uses
<b>Basil Lemon</b> Ocimum basilicum	a, fs, bf	24"-36"	Lemon-scented leaves are good in salads and teas. White flowers
<b>Basil Pesto Perpetuo</b> Ocimum x citriodorum	a, fs, bf	24"-48"	Greek Columnar basil, upright with light green leaves edged creamy white. Rarely flowers
<b>Basil Sweet</b> Ocimum basilicum	a, fs, bf	24"-36"	Fragrant, green leaves. Most popular variety of basil
<b>Basil Thai Siam Queen</b> Ocimum basilicum	a, fs, bf	18"-24"	Anise flavor basil. Culinary use in Asian & Thai dishes
<b>Catmint Blue Wonder</b> Nepeta faassenii	p, fs, dr Zones 3-8	12"-15"	Highly aromatic blue violet flowers May-September. Grey green leaves form into a compact spreading clump. Good for borders or herb gardens
<b>Catnip</b> Nepeta cataria	p, fs, bf, dr	24"-36"	Leaves can be used in tea. Intoxicating effect on cats
<b>Chamomile German</b> Matricaria recutita	a, fs, bf, dr	18"24"	Daisy flowers are dried and used for tea
<b>Chives</b> Allium schoenoprasum	p, fs, bf, dr	8"-12"	Onion flavored leaves, culinary use
<b>Cilantro</b> Coriandrum sativum	a, fs	12"-18"	Leaves are used to flavor Mexican dishes, salads, soups, and beans
<b>Coriander Vietnamese</b> Persicaria odorata	tp, fs	12"-18"	Cilantro-flavored leaves are used in salads and to flavor meats
<b>Curry</b> Helichrysum italicum	tp, fs	24"-48"	Silver leaves are used to flavor rice, vegetables, and eggs
<b>Dill</b> Anethum graveolens	b, fs, dr	24"-36"	Ferny leaves flavor potatoes, eggs, fish and seafood. The seeds are used in pickles
<b>Echinacea</b> Echinacea angustifolia	p, fs, bf	24"-48"	Purple flowers in summer. Medicinal use. Seed pods are favored by goldfinches.
<b>Fennel Bronze</b> Foeniculum vulgare rubrum	p, fs, bf	36"-48"	Anise-flavored, feathery, bronze leaves
<b>Germander Upright</b> Teucrium chamaedrys	p, fs, dr	12"-24"	Glossy foliage with lavender flowers, nice in a knot garden
<b>Hyssop Blue Flower</b> Hyssopus officinalis	p, fs, bf	18"-36"	Blue-flowered variety used in soups, salads and meat dishes
<b>Lavender Arctic Snow</b> Lavandula x intermedia	p, fs, bf, hb, dr Zone 5	18"-24"	White flowered lavender on small spikes
<b>Lavender Bridget Chloe</b> Lavandula x intermedia	p, fs, bf	10"-12"	Sport of Lavandula 'Provence'. Hardy in hot, humid environment. Long-lasting aromatic dried flower buds.

<b>Lavender Fringed French</b> Lavandula dentata	tp, fs, bf, hb, dr	24"	Green leaves with serrated edges and purple flowers
<b>Lavender Goodwin Creek</b> Lavandula heterophylla	tp, fs, bf, hb, dr	24"	Silvery foliage with lavender-blue flowers. Not hardy below 20 degrees

<b>Marjoram Golden</b> Origanum majorana aureum	tp, fs, bf, dr	6"-8"	Small, yellow, puckered leaves and creeping habit, highly ornamental; not much aroma
<b>Marjoram Sweet</b> Origanum majorana	tp, fs, bf, dr	18"-24"	Green leaves on an upright form. Used in sauces, soups and meat dishes
<b>Marigold Mexican Mint</b> Tagetes lucida	a, fs	24"-36"	Yellow flowers above green leaves. May be used as a substitute for Tarragon
<b>Mint Basil</b> Mentha piperita citrata	p, fs/ps, bf, hb, dr	12"-24"	Mint that smells like basil
<b>Mint Berries and Cream</b> Mentha hybrida	p, fs/ps, bf, hb, dr	14"-16"	Semi-upright with dark green foliage. Unique flavor and aroma
<b>Mint Corsican</b> Mentha requienii	tp, fs/ps, bf, hb, dr	> .5"	Pungent, round leaves form a dense mat, nice between flagstones, used to flavor liqueurs
<b>Mint Double</b> Mentha peperita spicata	p, fs/ps,bf, hb, dr	12"-24"	Large leaf, nice flavors of both spearmint & peppermint. Lavender flower. Culinary
<b>Mint Emerald and Gold</b> Mentha x gracilis variegata	p, fs/ps, bf, hb, dr	12"-24"	Green and gold, variegated leaves in cool temperatures. Used to flavor melon, tomatoes, fruit salads and teas
<b>Mint Julep</b> Mentha spicata	p, fs/ps, bf, hb, dr	12"-24"	Green, spearmint-flavored leaves are used in drinks
<b>Mint Mojito</b> Mentha x villosa	p, fs/ps, bf, hb, dr	8"-10"	Leaves are bright and dark green. Originally from Cuba. Classically known as the official mint for the mojito beverage.
<b>Mint Orange</b> Mentha x piperita	p, fs/ps, bf, hb, dr	12"-24"	Green leaves tinged with purple are used in teas, salads and iced drinks
<b>Mint Pennyroyal</b> Mentha pulegium	p, ps, bf, hb, dr	6"-8"	Low growing leaves have culinary and medicinal use, essential oils used in aromatherapy. Insect repellent

<b>Mint Pineapple</b> Mentha suaveolens variegata	p, fs/ps, bf, hb, dr	12"-24"	Green leaves have cream-colored variegation and a fruity fragrance. Used in mint sauces, teas, iced drinks and salads
<b>Mint Spearmint</b> Mentha spicata	p, fs/ps, bf, hb, dr	24"-36"	Green leaves are used in mint sauce, teas, iced drinks and salads
<b>Mint Spearmint Kentucky Colonel</b> Mentha spicata	p, fs/ps, bf, hb, dr	24"-36"	Not as aggressive a grower as Spearmint. Used to flavor drinks, salads and sauces
<b>Mint Strawberry</b> Mentha spicata	p, fs/ps	8"-24"	Petite green leaves have a fruity scent and flavor. Size makes this variety suitable for containers and hanging baskets. Many culinary uses.
<b>Mint Thai</b> Mentha arvensis	p, fs/ps	12" - 24"	Green foliage has hints of caraway and a slight citrus aroma. Culinary purposes.
<b>Oregano Italian</b> Origanum x majoricum	tp, fs, bf, hb, dr	18"-24"	All-purpose Oregano, green leaves
<b>Oregano Golden</b> Origanum vulgare aureum	p, fs, bf, hb, dr	6"-12"	Bright yellow leaves, spreading habit. Used in Italian, Greek and Mexican cooking

<b>Oregano Mexican Poliomintha</b> Poliomenantha longiflora	tp, fs	18"-24"	Tiny, bright green leaves with pink, tubular flowers. Oregano flavor and aroma
<b>Parsley Curly</b> Petroselinum crispum	b, fs	8"-12"	Curly leaves are used in salads and many dishes; often used as a garnish
<b>Parsley Menuette</b> Petroselinum crispum	b, fs	8"-12"	"Dill-like" leaves with parsley taste. Used for culinary purposes
<b>Parsley Plain</b> Petroselinum neapolitanum	b, fs	12"-24"	Dark green leaves with flat segments, strong flavor. Used to flavor sauces, butter, and assorted dishes
<b>Patchouli</b> Pogostemon cablin	a, fs	24"-36"	Large leaves are valued for their fragrance. Used in potpourri, oils and incense
<b>Rosemary Abraxas</b> Rosmarianus officinalis	p, fs, bf, hb, dr Zone 6-10	48" - 60"	Upright variety with light green foliage and blue flowers. Strong aroma and flavor, used for culinary purposes.
<b>Rosemary Arp</b> Rosmarianus officinalis	p, fs, bf, hb, dr Zones 8-10	24"-36"	Very hardy, to 15 degrees with protection. Gray-green leaves and light-blue flowers. Discovered in Arp, Texas
<b>Rosemary Barbeque</b> Rosmarianus officinalis	tp, fs, bf, hb,dr Zones 8-10	48"-60"	Light green leaves with nice aroma. Gets its name because the plant stem can be used as a kabob and it flavors your food while it's grilling
<b>Rosemary Blue Rain</b> Rosmarianus officinalis	tp, fs, bf, hb,dr Zones 8-10	6"-8"	Long runners with long lasting, light blue flowers. Good prostrate variety for hanging baskets, container gardening. In warm climates will spill down over walls
<b>Rosemary Foresteri</b> Rosmarianus officinalis	tp, fs, bf, hb,dr Zones 8-10	36"-48"	Dark green leaves with blue flowers, upright shrub form
<b>Rosemary Foxtail</b> Rosmarianus officinalis	tp, fs, bf, hb,dr Zones 8-10	36"-48"	Foliage grows with a plume-like habit. Pale blue flowers early to mid-summer. Culinary. Reaches 12"-16" in height.
<b>Rosemary Gorizia</b> Rosmarianus officinalis	tp, fs, bf, hb, dr	48"-60"	Large, green leaves on sturdy stems, blue flowers. Named after Gorizia, Italy. Hardy to 25 degrees
<b>Rosemary Hill Hardy</b> Rosmarianus officinalis	p, fs, bf, hb, dr	36"-40"	Fragrant, needlelike leaves and blue flowers. Survives temperatures down to 15 degrees

<b>Rosemary Upright</b> Rosmarianus officinalis	tp, fs, bf, hb, dr Zones 8-10	24"-36"	Dense, multi-stemmed, lavender flowers at the ends of the stems in early spring. Culinary
<b>Rosemary Prostrate</b> Rosmarianus officinalis	tp, fs, bf, hb, dr Zones 8-10	8"-12"	Trailing form looks nice as a ground cover or in baskets
<b>Rosemary Salem</b> Rosmarianus officinalis	p, fs, bf, hb, dr Zones 8-10	36"-48"	Dark green foliage with purple flowers. Upright growth habit

<b>Sage Golden Variegated</b> Salvia officinalis ictarina	p, fs, bf, hb, dr	18"	Yellow-and-green, variegated leaves. Used to flavor meat, soups and teas
<b>Sage Grower's Friend</b> Salvia officinalis	p, fs, bf, hb, dr	18"-32"	Green foliage, rarely blooms. Flavors meat and soups
<b>Sage Pineapple</b> Salvia elegans	tp, fs, bf, hb, dr	36"-60"	Light green leaves are pineapple-scented. Used in cold drinks or fruit salads. Showy, red flowers
<b>Sage Purple</b> Salvia officinalis purpurascens	p, fs, bf, hb, dr	18"-24"	Purple-gray foliage. Used to flavor meat and soups
<b>Sage Tricolor</b> Salvia officinalis	p, fs, bf, hb, dr	15"-18"	Irregular pink and ivory variegation
<b>Santolina Gray</b> Chamaecyparissus	p, fs, dr	24"	Silver-gray, highly aromatic foliage; yellow flowers. Ornamental; nice in knot gardens
<b>Savory Winter</b> Satureja montana	p, fs, bf, dr	15"	Fragrant, green foliage is used to flavor beans, meats and marinades. White flowers
<b>Savory Winter Dwarf</b> Satureja nana	p, fs, bf, dr	6"-12"	Dwarf version of Winter Savory with the same uses
<b>Sorrel French</b> Rumex acetosa	p, fs, ps	36"	Long, tangy flavored leaves are used in soups and salads. Grows in moist soil. Keep trimmed for better flavor
<b>Sorrel Red Veined</b> Rumex sanguineus	p, fs, ps	1'-3'	Contrasting dark maroon veins add color and taste to salad mix. Same sharp, tangy flavor as regular sorrel
<b>Stevia</b> Stevia rebaudiana	tp, fs	24'	Green leaves, white flowers. Used as a sugar substitute
<b>Tarragon French</b> Artemisia dracunculus	p, fs, dr	36"	Narrow, green leaves have a licorice aroma. Used in salad dressing, egg dishes, sauces, and to flavor meat dishes
<b>Thyme Archers Gold</b> Thymus citriodorus	p, fs, bf, dr	6"-9"	Bright yellow leaves that do not fade, pale purple flowers. Good for walkways
