### Ordering Quantity:

> Our plants are grown in 51 of split 102 liners. Each liner contains 51 plugs and are 1" hex in size.

> Minimum quantity to order is 50 plugs per plant variety.

> Liner prices are based on the nearest tenth integer, meaning the additional 1 plug is not charged.



### Prebooking & Early Order Discount (EOD):

> **Placing your prebook in advance may grant you a discount on your order.**

> EOD orders must be placed by October 15, 2026, for shipment January 4 to June 28, 2027.

> Minimum order required to receive EOD is 1,200 plugs (24 liners) per ship date.

### EOD Guide:

\$1.00 off per 100 plugs on orders of 1200 plugs.

\$1.50 off per 100 plugs on orders of 1300 to 4000 plugs.

\$2.00 off per 100 plugs on orders of 4100 plugs or more.

\*Early Order Discount is applied to the final invoice\*



## Prebooking:

> Prebook orders are orders placed in advance of your growing season.

> Your order is put into production at least 12 weeks ahead of your selected ship date to ensure optimal size for shipping and transplanting. **The 12 week lead time is required.**

> **Ship dates for late February to early April will likely sell out before October 31st.** If an order is placed for a week that is sold out, we will move it to our next available date and note the change on your acknowledgement.

> In the event it is too late to prebook your order, excess availability is available to order from the week before your selected ship date.

**\*\*Production changes and cancellations are handled on a case-by-case basis\*\***

## Weekly Excess Availability:

> Our excess availability are any extra plants left over from prebook sales.

- Excess availability does not have a specific day that it goes live, but we strive to host it every week.

> We do not sell these trays in advance. They are available to ship the following week only.

**\*\*Late February - early April (weeks 9-15), we may not have an excess availability due to our shipping capacity being reached.\*\***

## Placing an Order:

> Prebook and excess orders can be placed online under their respective tabs.

> You will need shipping and billing info, and payment information upon placing your order.

- Please note: Credit/debit payments are not processed until the week before the order ship date.

> For full boxing we can ship 8, 6, or 4 liners in our boxes. We do not have an order minimum.

- 8-6 liners fit in a large box

- 4 or less ships in a small box.

## Plant Tags:

- > Plant tags are available for \$8.50 per bundle of 50.
- > **A restocking fee of 5% will be charged if tags are cancelled from an order.**
- > Tags are required for patented herbs with a royalty charge.
- > Tags may not be available for all items.



## Shipping & Freight:

- > We ship via UPS and FedEx. Air cargo collect is available under select circumstances.
  - > Freight is determined based on location and selected service. UPS is usually the cheapest.
  - > Customer pick-up is available Tuesday-Friday, 7-2, with notice to our office.
  - > Boxes can hold:
    - Large Box: 8-6 liners
    - Small Box: 4 or less liners
- \*\*During extreme temperatures, we reserve the right to delay shipping until safe for plant material\*\***



## Additional Charges:

- > Boxing charge: \$9.30/box.
- > Drayage charge to airport: \$6.00/box.
- > Winter boxing: \$5.00/box.
  - Winter boxing is required in the case of extreme cold or weather conditions that would result in unhealthy plants upon delivery.

> Initial claim via email is necessary within 24 hours of delivery.

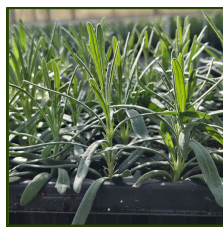

<b>Balm Lemon</b> <i>Melissa officinalis</i>	p, fs, bf, dr	12" - 18"	Fresh lemon flavor for culinary and medicinal purposes.
<b>Basil African Blue</b> <i>Ocimum kilimandscharicum</i> x <i>basilicum</i>	a, fs, bf	36" - 48"	Edible green-purple foliage and flower spikes. Culinary and medicinal purposes.
<b>Basil Amethyst</b> <i>Ocimum basilicum</i>	a, fs, bf	16" - 20"	Beautiful purple foliage that are almost black. The darkest purple basil with a classic basil flavor.
<b>Basil Genovese</b> <i>Ocimum basilicum</i>	a, fs, bf	24" - 36"	Sweet flavored basil that is the most favorable for making pesto.
<b>Basil Greek Columnar</b> <i>Ocimum</i> x <i>citriodorum</i>	a, fs, bf	24" - 36"	Bold and strong basil flavor. Grows in an upright and narrow habit.
<b>Basil Holy Kapoor Tulsi</b> <i>Ocimum africanum</i>	a, fs, bf	12" - 18"	Sweet flavored basil that is commonly used in teas. Culinary and medicinal purposes.
<b>Basil Lemon</b> <i>Ocimum basilicum</i>	a, fs, bf	24" - 36"	Lemon/basil flavors and aromatics with white flowers.

<b>Basil Sweet</b> <i>Ocimum basilicum</i>	a, fs, bf	24" - 36"	Sweet basil flavor, less bold flavors than the Genovese variety.
<b>Basil Thai Siam Queen</b> <i>Ocimum basilicum</i>	a, fs, bf	18" - 24"	Strong licorice-sweet flavored basil that remains stable at high cooking temperatures.
<b>Catmint Blue Wonder</b> <i>Nepeta racemosa</i>	p, fs, dr Zones 3-8	12" - 15"	Highly aromatic blue violet flowers May-Sept. Grey green leaves form into a compact spreading clump.
<b>Catnip</b> <i>Nepeta cataria</i>	p, fs, bf, dr	24" - 36"	Foliage popular in tea for medicinal purposes, as well as popular with cats.
<b>Chamomile German</b> <i>Matricaria recutita</i>	a, fs, bf, dr	18" - 24"	The flowers are commonly used for tea. Culinary and medicinal purposes.

<b>Lavender Bridget Chloe</b> Lavandula x intermedia	p, fs, bf	10" - 12"	Sport of Lavandula 'Provence'. Hardy in hot, humid environments. Long-lasting aromatic flower buds.
<b>Lavender Dutch</b> Lavandula x intermedia	p, fs, bf, hb, dr Zone 5	24" - 36"	Large silver foliage with lavender flower spikes. Classic lavender aroma and uses.
<b>Lavender Edelweiss</b> Lavandula x intermedia	p, fs, bf, hb, dr Zone 5	24" - 36"	Long white flowered spikes with silver foliage. Sweet smelling lavender that attracts pollinators.

<b>Mint Corsican</b> <i>Mentha requienii</i>	tp, fs/ps, bf, hb, dr	>.5" - 1"	Tiny round leaves form a dense mat. Strong mint aroma, medicinal and culinary uses.
<b>Mint Double</b> <i>Mentha spicata</i>	p, fs/ps,bf, hb, dr	12" - 24"	Large foliage with flavors of both spearmint and peppermint. Aromatic, culinary, and medicinal uses.
<b>Mint Emerald and Gold</b> <i>Mentha x gracilis</i>	p, fs/ps, bf, hb, dr	12" - 24"	Green foliage that gains gold variegation in cooler temperatures.

<b>Rosemary Barbeque</b> Rosmarianus officinalis	tp, fs, bf, hb,dr Zones 8-10	48" - 60"	Light green foliage with nice aroma. The strong plant stem can be used as a kabob for grilling.
<b>Rosemary Blue Rain</b> Rosmarianus officinalis	tp, fs, bf, hb,dr Zones 8-10	6" - 8"	Long runners with lasting, light blue flowers. Trailing variety for hanging baskets or other containers.
<b>Rosemary Foresteri</b> Rosmarianus officinalis	tp, fs, bf, hb,dr Zones 8-10	36" - 48"	Dark green leaves with blue flowers, upright shrub form. Sharp and pungent rosemary flavor.
<b>Rosemary Foxtail</b> Rosmarianus officinalis	tp, fs, bf, hb,dr Zones 8-10	36" - 48"	Foliage grows with a plume-like habit. Pale blue flowers early to mid-summer. Culinary uses.
